## **Privacy Policy Updates**

## **Information Collection and Use**

## **Reminder Alerts**

You may choose to allow our services to provide reminder alerts. Should you allow reminder alerts, you understand and agree that this service may be provided using services operated outside of SocialClimb’s control, including, but not limited to, systems such as Apple, Inc.’s push notification. ## **Children's Privacy**

## **Aggregate Information**

The Site may track the total number of visitors to our Site, the number of visitors to each page of our Site, browser type, IP addresses, linked External Web Sites (defined below), and we may analyze this data for trends and statistics in the aggregate, but such information will be maintained, used and disclosed in aggregate form only and it will not contain personally identifiable information. We may use such aggregate information to analyze trends, administer the Site, track users' movement, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use.

## **Disclosure**

We may provide personally identifiable information and the data generated by cookies and other aggregate information to the vendors and service agencies that we may engage to assist us in providing our services to you. For example, we may provide your personally identifiable information to a credit card processing company to process your payment. It is the policy of SocialClimb to adhere to all applicable laws and principles affecting the collection, processing and maintenance of personally identifiable information.
